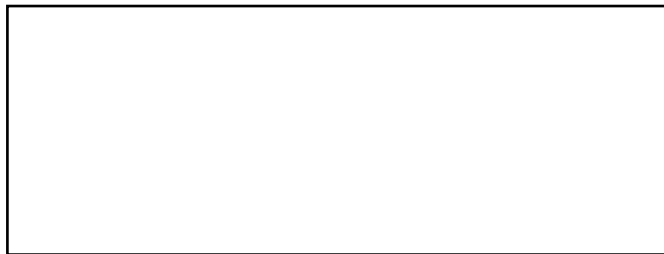

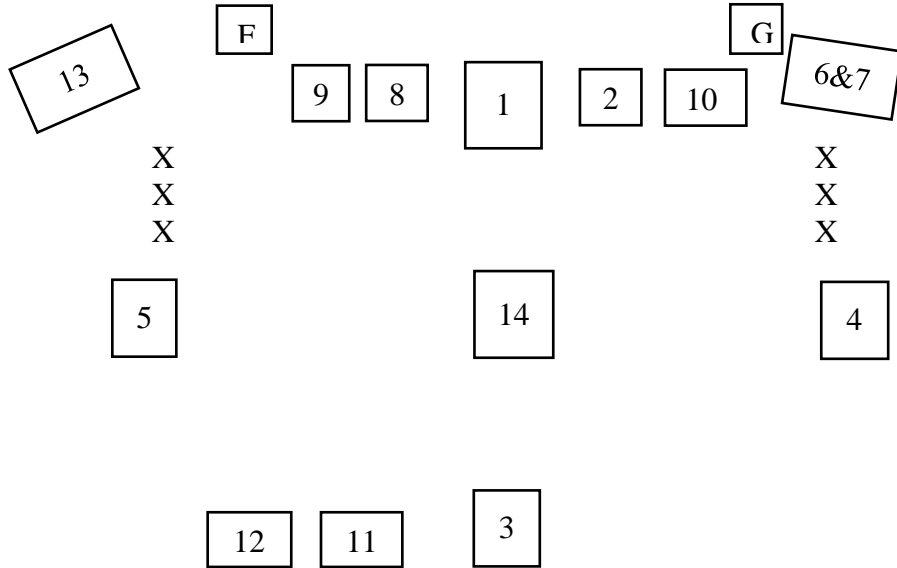

1. Raps

2. Obligation sign:

Extend your right hand over your heart.



3. Saluting the Flag:

right hand over right eyebrow,
fingers together, palm out,
thumb folded in



4. Addressing President: OPTIONAL

left hand slightly curved,

5. Regalia: OPTIONAL

White skirt or white slacks, and white top, or white dress,
Purple jacket, regulation Royal Purple hat.
