

**RESOLUTIONS PASSED AT CRPS AGM – JULY 13, 2020**

**Resolution #1:**

**Resolution #2:**

The National President will no longer receive a cream coloured hat with a purple tassel as they are unavailable, however a Past National President may continue to wear their hat if they wish.

**Resolution #3:**

The Past National President's jewel is no longer available, so now upon completion of their term, the National President will be presented with her name tag/pin and other gifts and will become a Life Member (Class B) of the Canadian Royal Purple Society.

**Resolution #4:**

Not all National Committees require 3 members and at times it is difficult to fill seats on some committees, the wording has been changed to “may consist of at least 2 members” on certain committees.

**Resolution #5:**

Tassels and jewels for recognition of Status are no longer available, this section has been removed from the Constitution.

**Resolution #6:**

Many Service Pins are no longer available; therefore the Section in the Constitution regarding Service Pins has been removed.

Lodges may purchase 5, 10, 25- and 40-year pins from the National Office and CRPS will recognize 50- and 60-year pins and 70 year certificates.

Members may receive recognition of years and/or service from their lodges in other forms such as provided for in the Lodge Bylaws.

**RECOMMENDATIONS PASSED AT THE 2020 CRPS AGM**  
**JULY 12-14, 2020**

**Recommendation #1**

**The Internal Review Committee recommended that invoices for insurance be sent to the lodges annually.**

**Recommendation #2**

**That special consideration be given to the Ontario Provincial Association to allow them to have a National Director for the 2020-2021 year and that the Constitution, Section 1, Article 2. C iii be held in abeyance until July 1, 2021.**

**Recommendation #3**

**That the community grant program be continued through the CRPS 2020-2021 fiscal year, enabling provinces to apply for subsequent \$2000 grants upon submission of their reports and enabling new lodges to continue to apply for \$2000 funding. These programs should continue to be funded by our investments.**

**Recommendation #4**

**That the Canadian Royal Purple Society continue to carry out the 2020/2021 Audit by Internal Review.**
